#### Math:

In math, we will begin chapter ten. This chapter explores threedimensional shapes.

Vocabulary: cone, cube, cylinder, face, rectangular prism, threedimensional shape

#### Language Arts:

Trick Words: been, little, own, want (Students will be given a spelling test on Friday containing the above trick words. Additionally, students will continue to be assessed on letter/sound identification and will now be asked to spell words matching the weekly Fundations skill.)

Fundations Skill: Two-Syllable Words with V-E Syllables: (e.g. mist<mark>ake</mark>, exc<mark>use</mark>, rept<mark>ile</mark>, flagp<mark>ole</mark>)

Sight Words: become, busy, eyes, high, listen, remembered, talk, visitor (Students must be able to read these words and put them into provided sentences on Thursday)

Reading Selections: -What Is In the Hedge? -Mystery of the Night Song (These stories will be read during class and a short comprehension assessment will take place on Thursday)

Robust Vocabulary Words: pleased, joy, stammered, puzzling, probing, unrelenting (Students must be able to determine the meaning of these words, in context, on Thursday)
