Math:

In math, we will work on two-digit addition and subtraction facts. Please continue to practice addition and subtraction facts through twenty at home.

Social Studies:

In social studies, students will learn about the state symbols of Ohio (e.g. state flag, flower, bird, tree, beverage, animal, reptile and insect).

Journal Prompt:

Writing homework journals will begin next week.

Language Arts:

Trick Words: her, over, number (Students will be given a spelling test on Friday containing the above trick words. Additionally, students will continue to be assessed on letter/sound identification and will now be asked to spell words matching the weekly Fundations skill.)

Fundations Skill:

- Digraph Blends: (e.g. lun<u>ch</u>, <u>sh</u>red)
- R-Controlled Vowels: er, ir, ur (e.g. her, bird, burn)

Sight Words: again, feel, house, know, loud, Mrs., put, say (Students must be able to read these words and put them into provided sentences on Thursday)

Reading Selections: -Ann's Trip to the Stars -Mark's Big Day (These stories will be read during class and a short comprehension assessment will take place on Thursday)

Robust Vocabulary Words: approached, energetic, pace, blunder, reassure, excel (Students must be able to determine the meaning of these words, in context, on Thursday)
