Math:

In math, students will learn how to tell time to the hour and half hour using a digital and analog clock.

Vocabulary: digital clock, analog clock, minute hand, hour hand, hour, half hour

Language Arts:

Foundations Skill:

Words with the suffix -s, -ed, -ing (e.g. rents/rented/renting)

Sight Words: **dear, door, hurry, mother, should, sky, told** (Students must be able to read these words and put them into provided sentences on Thursday)

Reading Selections:

-Beaver's Green Treat

-Little Rabbit's Tale

(These stories will be read during class and a short comprehension assessment will take place on Thursday)

Robust Vocabulary Words: **courteous, devious, rapidly, gullible, hastily, unreasonable** (Students must be able to determine the meaning of these words, in context, on Thursday)
