Reading Selections: -The Missing Cake -Flake, the Missing Hamster (These stories will be read during class and a short comprehension assessment will take place on Thursday)

Robust Vocabulary Words: sympathy, sensitive, devoted, alarmed, mysterious, overjoyed (Students must be able to determine the meaning of these words, in context, on Thursday)
