Math:

In math, we will now begin chapter nine. This chapter explores two-dimensional shapes.

Vocabulary: square, rectangle, triangle, trapezoid, circle, sides, vertices

Social Studies:

In social studies, students will compare types of transportation used today and long ago.

Vocabulary: technology

Language Arts:

Trick Words: **none, nothing** (Students will be given a spelling test on Friday containing the above trick words. Additionally, students will continue to be assessed on letter/sound identification and will now be asked to spell words matching the weekly Foundations skill.)

Foundations Skill:

Vowel-Consonant-E: (e.g. quake, whale, slide, white) When "e" is added to the end of a word, the vowel becomes long.

Sight Words: **around, found, gone, hears, might, near, open, tired** (Students must be able to read these words and put them into provided sentences on Thursday)

Reading Selections:

-The Missing Cake

-Flake, the Missing Hamster

(These stories will be read during class and a short comprehension assessment will take place on Thursday)

Robust Vocabulary Words: **sympathy, sensitive, devoted, alarmed, mysterious, overjoyed** (Students must be able to determine the meaning of these words, in context, on Thursday)
