In math, students will learn how to measure and take data using nonstandard forms of measurement.

Vocabulary: measure, length, unit

Social Studies:

Reading Selections: -Shadow in the Snow -Snow Surprise (These stories will be read during class and a short comprehension assessment will take place on Thursday)

Robust Vocabulary Words: bulged, jostled, argue, command, labored, wary (Students must be able to determine the meaning of these words, in context, on Thursday)
