#### Math:

In math, students will review graphing skills this week (e.g. tally charts, picture graphs and bar graphs).

Suffix -es: When words end in ch, sh, s, x or z, add -es to make the word plural. (e.g. boxes, bosses, benches, rashes)

Sight Words: answered, baby, done, heard, pools, pushed, together (Students must be able to read these words and put them into provided sentences on Thursday)

Reading Selections: -What Brad Found -Ebb and Flo (These stories will be read during class and a short comprehension assessment will take place on Thursday)

Robust Vocabulary Words: quivered, wailed, scattered, elated, lonesome, hopeless (Students must be able to determine the meaning of these words, in context, on Thursday)
