Math:

In math, students will review addition and subtraction strategies through twenty.

Social Studies:

In social studies, students will learn ways people trade money for goods and services. Additionally, students will recognize the purpose of saving money.

Vocabulary Words:
market, save, trade

Journal Prompt:

Hale Farm is a really cool place to visit!

Language Arts:

Trick Words: **look**, **good**, **new** (Students will be given a spelling test on Friday containing the above trick words. Additionally, students will continue to be assessed on letter/sound identification and will now be asked to spell words matching the weekly Foundations skill.)

Foundations Skill:

Suffix -es: When words end in ch, sh, s, x or z, add -es to make the word plural. (e.g. splashes, munches, finishes)

Sight Words: **able**, **almost**, **blue**, **great**, **poured**, **took**, **traveled** (Students must be able to read these words and put them into provided sentences on Thursday)

Reading Selections:

-Patty's Family Sketches
-At the Crayon Factory
(These stories will be read during class and a short comprehension assessment will take place on Thursday)

Robust Vocabulary Words: **properly**, **familiar**, **arrived**, **anticipate**, **numerous**, **vibrant** (Students must be able to determine the meaning of these words, in context, on Thursday)

Wednesday: Study Sight Words & Robust Words
Thursday: Study Trick Words
Friday: Writing Journal Due
