Math:

Social Studies:

Language Arts:

Fundations Skill:

Suffix -es: When words end in ch, sh, s, x or z, add -es to make the word plural. (e.g. splashes, munches, finishes)

Sight Words: able, almost, blue, great poured, took, traveled (Students must be able to read these words and put them into provided sentences on Thursday)

Reading Selections:

- -Patty's Family Sketches
- -At the Crayon Factory

(These stories will be read during class and a short comprehension assessment will take place on Thursday)

Robust Vocabulary Words: properly, familiar, arrived, anticipate, numerous, vibrant (Students must be able to determine the meaning of these words, in context, on Thursday)
