Math:

In math, we will continue to learn about subtraction concepts in chapter four. This week we will cover: using a number line, creating doubles and making ten to subtract. We will also practice writing a number sentence to solve a word problem.

Social Studies:

In social studies, students will continue to learn about map and globe skills. This week students will create a flip chart to help demonstrate new vocabulary words. Please review your home address and phone number with your child.

Vocabulary Words: Earth, globe, continent, ocean

Language Arts:

Trick Words: **who, what, when**
(Students will be given a spelling test on Friday containing the above trick words. Additionally, students will continue to be assessed on letter/sound identification and will now be asked to spell words matching the weekly Foundations skill.)

Foundations Skill: basewords & the -s suffix (e.g. shell...shells, rock...rocks, sip...sips)

Sight Words: **be, does, food, grow live, many**
(Students must be able to read these words and put them into provided sentences on Thursday)

Reading Selections:

-A Nut Falls

-Plants Can't Jump

(These stories will be read during class and a short comprehension assessment will take place on Thursday)

Robust Vocabulary Words: claimed, dine, groaned, function, nutritious, classify
(Robust words are taught during class, but will not be tested at this point in time.)
