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## Weekly Curriculum Guide



### Math:

In math, we will conclude chapter three this week. A math test has been scheduled for Wednesday, November 6, 2013. A math review will be sent home on Tuesday night to practice chapter three concepts.

### Social Studies:

In social studies, students will learn about map and globe skills. This week, students will learn how to explain the differences between maps and globes. Additionally, students will learn how to locate the seven continents and four oceans on a map and globe.

Vocabulary Words: Earth, globe, continent, ocean

### Language Arts:

Trick Words: **are**, **were** (Students will be given a spelling test on Friday containing the above trick words. Additionally, students will continue to be assessed on letter/sound identification and will now be asked to spell words matching the weekly Foundations skill.)

Foundations Skill: basewords & the -s suffix (e.g. pet...pets, dog...dogs, bug...bugs)

Sight Words: **don't**, **her**, **line**, **Mr.**, **new**, **says**, **water** (Students must be able to read these words and put them into provided sentences on Thursday)

-Beth's Job

(These stories will be read during class and a short comprehension assessment will take place on Thursday)

Robust Vocabulary Words: applauded, chatty, gather, duty, envy, resent (Robust words are taught during class, but will not be tested at this point in time.)
