Weekly Curriculum Guide



Math:

In math, we will conclude chapter two this week. A math test has been scheduled for Wednesday, October 16, 2013. A review of chapter two skills will be sent home for homework on Tuesday, October 15, 2013.

Social Studies:

In social studies, students will identify behaviors that show respect for others. Students will also learn about rights that individuals have and responsibilities that accompany these rights.

Vocabulary Words: right, respect

Language Arts:

Trick Words: you, your, I, they
(Students will be given a spelling test on Friday containing the above trick words. Additionally, students will continue to be assessed on letter/sound identification and will now be asked to spell words matching the weekly Foundations skill pattern.)

Foundations Skill: Bonus letters in words with short vowels: s, l, f
(e.g. miss, tell, cuff)

Sight Words: find, much, thank
(Students must be able to read these words and put them into provided sentences on Thursday)

Reading Selections:
Jobs, Dot and Bob
(These stories will be read during class and a short comprehension assessment will take place on Thursday)

Robust Vocabulary Words:
horrible, invigorated, presented, sweltering, aid, persistent
(Robust words are taught during class, but will not be tested at this point in time.)
