Math:

In math, we will continue to work on subtraction skills. This week students will learn how to subtract numbers six through ten.

Vocabulary Review Words: difference, compare

Social Studies:

In social studies, students will learn about voting. Additionally, explore services provided by the government and how they provide for a community's needs.

Vocabulary Words: vote, president, ballot. government service

Language Arts:

Trick Words: we, he, she, be, me, for, or (Students will be given a spelling test on Friday containing the above trick Additionally, students continue to be assessed on letter/sound identification and will now be asked to spell words matching the weekly Fundations skill pattern.)

Fundations Skill: Consonant Digraphs: wh, ch, sh, th, ck (e.g. mash, chop, duck, ship)

Sight Words: late, oh, yes (Students must be able to read these words and put them into provided sentences Thursday)

Reading Selections:

Pick a Sack, Get Up, Rick! (these stories will be read during class and a short comprehension assessment will take place on Thursday)

Robust Vocabulary pouted, ambled, politely, routine, considerate, unexpected (Robust words are taught during class, but will not be tested at this point in time.)
