Math:

In math, we will continue to explore operations and algebraic thinking through addition concepts. In the upcoming week, we will focus on vertical addition, writing a number sentence and ways to make four through seven.

Helpful Hint: Each math lesson contains four workbook pages. Students complete these pages as a class during math time. These pages are then stapled and sent home each evening. You do not have to return them to school.

Social Studies:

In social studies, we will continue to explore school rules.

Vocabulary Words: teacher, rule, responsibility, principal, fair

Language Arts:

This week, students will review the letters: a, g, d, s, e, r, p and Student assessments kindergarten sight words will be sent home this week. These are the sight words that students should have mastered kindergarten. Please practice and reinforce any sight words on the list that have been highlighted.

On Wednesday, September 4, 2013, the entire first grade will take part in DIBELS testing. This assessment helps identify early literacy and math skills.
